Regardless of your particular circumstances, obtaining a divorce is substantially the same process and has the same considerations.

For example:

1. Your marriage must have broken down "irretrievably" which is evidenced by twelve months' separation.
2. We have a 'no fault' system, so you don't have to prove someone did the wrong thing.
3. There is a fairly precise process that has to be followed to obtain a divorce. You have to file an Application with the Court and demonstrate that your ex partner is aware of your application.
4. The court must be satisfied that proper arrangements have been made for any children of the relationship who are under 18 years of age.
